# Daily Routine




- Gates open at 8.30, but children are unsupervised until doors open.



## Homework

- Reading/spellings/ times tables every night.

- Set homework- Both pieces on a Thursday and handed in on a Wednesday.
- Two pieces one Maths, the other English, Topic or Science
- Children to spend between one and two hours a week on homework.
- · Homework books provided.
- Mathletics Mathletics award at least once a fortnight is expected and monitored.
