

PE and Sport Grant Funding and Expenditure 2015/2016

- The government has committed to provide additional funding of £150 million for the academic years 2015/16 to improve the provision of PE and sport in primary schools. This funding is ring-fenced and can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools. Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport, for the benefit of pupils, in the 2015 to 2016 academic year, to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

Our aim is to raise achievement throughout the whole curriculum supported by high quality physical education and sports at St. Lawrence C of E Junior School. Every child will receive a high standard of PE teaching due to quality teacher training.

This has been achieved through:

- Improving the provision of PE and sport by improving PE provision through continuing professional development (CPD), and developing the knowledge skills and capacity of the teaching staff to enable them to deliver high quality PE lessons.
- Developing skills and competence in specific sports and improving performance by introducing the children to a wide range of sports through the use of external sports coaches.
- Increasing healthy activities for the children during the school day
- Maintaining participation levels in competitive sport, working closely with Mark Simmonds from Active Surrey and the Esher District Primary Schools Sports Association (EPDSSA) to take part in as many opportunities for competitive sport as was feasible throughout the year. We also provide a variety of after school sports clubs to encourage pupils to engage in sport outside school.
